The public will: 1) receive a report from staff on the redistricting process and permissible criteria to be considered to redraw Board of Supervisors election district boundaries; and 2) conduct a public workshop to receive public input on communities of interest and potential district boundaries.

Pursuant to Governor Gavin Newsom's Executive Order pertaining to the convening of public meetings in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the County of Nevada will hold this public meeting from inside the Board Chambers, located at the Eric Rood Administrative Center, 950 Maidu Avenue, First Floor, Nevada City, CA 95959. To remain in compliance with the state's public health guidance, face coverings are required to be worn by individuals who are not fully vaccinated.
