
In accordance with the provisions of Section 2279 of the California Food and Agricultural Code, I am pleased to submit the 1981 Crop and Livestock Report for Nevada County.

This report, for the first time, shows the value of timber. The 1981 value for Nevada County was up 3.8 million dollars over 1981. This large increase is due to 2.5 million from timber sales and a 1.3 million increase in poultry sales.

These figures show only gross values and do not reflect cost of production nor net income of the grower.

I wish to thank everyone that supplied the information that made this report possible. A special thanks to Eric Gunderson of my staff who compiled this report.
