<p>January 9, 2017 EC 9313, 9316, 9315</p>	<p>Deadline to File Arguments</p> <p>Arguments for or against any local measures called for the March 7, 2017 election are due by 5:00 P.M.</p>
<p>January 10-19, 2017 (E-80 to E-71) EC Sec 9316</p>	<p>10-Day Public Inspection for Arguments and Analysis</p> <p>10-day public inspection of arguments filed by January 19, 2017. During the 10-calendar-day public examination period any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the county elections official, himself or herself, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.</p>
<p>January 16, 2017 (E-74) EC Sec 9317</p>	<p>Deadline for Filing Rebuttals to Measures</p> <p>On this date Rebuttal Arguments will be due by 5 P.M.</p>
<p>January 17-26, 2017 (E-73-E-63) EC Sec 9190, 9380</p>	<p>10-Day Public Inspection for Rebuttals</p> <p>10-calendar-day public inspection of rebuttals filed by January 26, 2017. During this period, any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.</p>
