

**Nevada County Activity Schedule for Placing a Measure on the Ballot  
for the November 8, 2016 General Election**

<p><b>July 6, 2016</b> (E-125) EC Sec 10402-10403</p>	<p><b>LAST DAY</b> for Governing Boards to file their resolution calling for and placing a measure on the ballot and requesting consolidation of their election with the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election. File the resolution with the Elections Official.</p> <p>This resolution must set forth the FULL TEXT OF THE MEASURE and the EXACT FORM OF THE QUESTION of any measure to appear on the ballot. If the question is the full text of the measure, this needs to be stated in the resolution.</p>
<p><b>August 12, 2016</b> (E-88) EC Sec 9401</p>	<p><b>Deadline</b> for Filing Tax Rate Statement for Bond Measures.</p> <p>County Counsel to submit impartial analysis for county and school/special district measures;</p> <p>City Attorney to submit impartial analysis of City measures;</p> <p>County Auditor, if previously directed by the Board of Supervisors, to submit fiscal analysis of measures;</p>
<p><b>August 19, 2016</b> (E-88) EC 9160, 9163, 9313, 9316, 9280</p>	<p><b>Deadline to File Arguments</b></p> <p>Arguments for or against any local measures called for the November 2016 election are due by 5:00 P.M. ;</p>
<p><b>August 20-29, 2016</b> (E-80 to E-71) EC Sec 9190</p>	<p><b>10-Day Public Inspection for Arguments and Analysis</b></p> <p>10-day public inspection of arguments filed by August 19, 2016. During the 10-calendar-day public examination period any voter of the jurisdiction in which the election is being held, or the county elections official, himself or herself, may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.</p>
<p><b>August 26, 2016</b> (E-74) EC Sec 9167, 9317</p>	<p><b>Deadline for Filing Rebuttals to Measures</b></p> <p>On this date Rebuttal Arguments will be due by 5 P.M.</p>

<p><b>August 27-September 6, 2016</b> (E-73 to E-63) EC Sec 9190, 9380</p>	<p><b>10-Day Public Inspection for Rebuttals</b> 10-calendar-day public inspection of rebuttals filed by August 26, 2016. During this period, any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.</p>
<p><b>Sept. 09, 2016 – Sept. 24, 2016</b> (E-60 to -45) EC Sec 3105</p>	<p><b>MILITARY AND OVERSEAS VOTER VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT DELIVERY PERIOD</b></p>
<p><b>October 10 - November 1, 2016</b> (E-29 to -7) EC Sec 3001</p>	<p><b>VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS MAILING PERIOD</b></p>
<p><b>October 24, 2016</b> (E-15) EC Sec 2107</p>	<p><b>CLOSE OF REGISTRATION</b></p>
