

The Grass Valley Veterans Memorial Building held its grand opening ceremony on April 23, 1932. Dances, plays, movies, boxing, wrestling and bowling were a few of the early events held in the building. The Veterans Building is a beautiful venue that is shared by the community for fundraisers, children's groups, dances and proms, musical concerts and theatrical productions, meetings, dinners, weddings, reunions and anniversaries. Several veterans groups, including the American Legion, Vietnam Veterans of American, and the Marine Corps League, use the building for their meetings and special events.

In 2008 the renovated building was rededicated to provide a modern flair to this historic venue..
