
Office of Manufactured Cannabis Safety

Rulemaking for State Regulations is underway and will address:

Licenses for testing labs, transporters, distributors, dispensaries and microbusiness

Licenses for cannabis cultivators and establishment of a track and trace system

Licenses for manufacturers of cannabis products, such as edibles



Brief Review Of How Other Counties Are Addressing Cannabis

Allowable Activities – General Definitions

Home-Based Activities: Activities undertaken as part of a business or commercial enterprise at a cultivation site

Manufacturing and Processing: Includes processes such as drying, cleaning, curing, packaging and extraction of the active ingredients of cannabis in order to create cannabis related products including edibles and topicals at a cultivation site

Transportation/Delivery: Services that deliver cannabis to an individual from a cultivation site

Allowable Activities – General Definitions

Testing Labs: Licensed laboratory that conducts sampling and analysis of cannabis and related goods

Nurseries: Facilities that produce immature plants and seeds for whole sale or sale at a cultivation site

Tasting Rooms: A facility where a person can purchase and sample various cannabis-related products at a cultivation site






















