

2018 POINT IN TIME COUNT RESULTS

272 People experiencing homelessness counted on January 24th, 2018

On the night of January 24th, 2018, the Homeless Resource Council of the Sierras - representing the joint Continuum of Care for Placer and Nevada Counties - conducted a Point In Time Count (PIT) to measure the number of individuals and families experiencing homelessness in our community.



The 2018 Point In Time results demonstrated a 27% decrease as compared to 2017. However, various factors can affect these results since they are performed on a single night - such as weather (this year the count was performed on a cold and snowy day), location of the event, etc.


