Comment Field/User Notes

The County has \$500,000 in obligated expenses for final payment on one remaining contract for broadband service to support distance learning and telecommuting within our rural community. All services were completed by 12/30/2020 and the final report out and payment are in process. The County has only claimed approximately 30% of its eligible payroll costs for Public Health and Safety Employees, and if necessary could increase this amount if the State wishes to show 100% of costs fully expended. We do however, expect this final obligation to be paid within the next 15 days. If additional CRF funds become available due to the State reallocating funding among jurisdictions the County could use additional funding. Nevada County has collaborated with the incorporated cities (Grass Valley and Nevada City) and the Truckee Township in its response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Nevada County has allocated \$415,000 to the police departments of these jurisdictions to aid with their response to the public health emergency as well as efforts to encourage compliance with the State Public Health Order. There is no duplication of effort as each entity, including Nevada County, is operating within its normal jurisdictional purview. Nevada County has also closely tracked other COVID-19 related funding, including potential FEMA reimbursable expenses as well as other COVID-10 related direct funding allocations, and has ensured that the expenditures included in the CRF state allocation to Nevada County have not been duplicated.

I am authorized by my employer, a recipient of federal Coronavirus Relief Funds (CRF) allocated by the State, to submit this expenditure report to the State.
