The instructors will share their leadership experiences related to operations, administration, and personnel management of a special operations unit.

STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO BRING: A laptop computer to review documents and prepare presentations, a copy of the agency's SWAT policies and procedures/guidelines, and a copy of the agency's threat assessment matrix.
