What you'll learn

This course is based on active student participation, utilizing practical exercises and learning activities, along with video simulations to enable participants to learn:

- How to develop, update, and submit an agency Field Training Program and manual for P.O.S.T. approval
- Field Training Program management and supervisory procedures.
- The various roles and responsibilities of Field Training Program personnel.
- Legal and liability issues in Field Training.
- Elements of and exercises in effective program documentation and evaluation.

Participants are requested to bring a copy of their agency Field Training Program manual and forms, along with all related Field Training issues, questions, problems, and successes for class discussion. Completion of this course satisfies the requirement for personnel assigned to supervise a POST-approved Field Training Program. Course instructors include current and former Field Training Program managers and supervisors, and F.T.O.s.

The class is limited to 26 students, and is subject to cancellation if the minimum enrollment of 15 is not met by March 7, 2022, so please register early.

Tuition

\$69.00 including enrollment and materials fees. For independent or self-pay public agency students attending on a off/on duty status there is an additional mandatory \$21 health fee payable once per semester.

Students will need to bring a laptop computer to download class materials electronically.

Successful completion of the course will earn 1.5 semester units of college credit (LE 353). Tuition and fees are payable to Allan Hancock College and may be made by check, money order or by credit card; public agency billings may also be arranged. POST certified and reimbursable under Plan II.

Attendance

Class will be held **Monday-Wednesday, 8:00am - 5:00 pm**. Students are expected to attend all scheduled course hours. POST requires a minimum of 90% attendance for successful course completion. When practical, short emergency absences may be made up by out-of-class assignments, by arrangement with the instructor (s) and course coordinator.

Location & Parking

Class will be held at Allan Hancock College, Lompoc Valley Center, Room 5-118 , One Hancock Drive, Lompoc, CA. The LVC is near the intersection of Hwy 1 and North H, at the north end of Lompoc.

Purchase a \$2.00 parking permit at the yellow Kiosk machine in front of building 5. Park in a white parking space. Yellow spaces are staff only. Exempt plated vehicles do not require parking permits.
