

Argument in Favor of Measure U

Vote Yes on U to renew expiring funding for Truckee's trails.

Since 2014, Truckee has relied upon dedicated, locally controlled funding to improve, expand and maintain Truckee's extensive trail network.

Our trails connect local neighborhoods with Downtown, the Truckee River, Donner Lake and beautiful open space throughout our region.

Local trails provide safe transportation options for pedestrians, bicyclists and students who walk or bike to school. Allowing residents and visitors to get around easily without driving a car, reduces greenhouse gas emissions, improves air quality and helps combat climate change.

Vote YES on U to renew expiring funding that will:

- Protect natural open space along trail corridors
- Continue construction of the paved Truckee River Legacy Trail all the way from Glenshire to Donner Lake
- Maintain and repair existing trails so they are kept in good condition all year
- Provide safer routes to schools for local children who walk or bike to school
- Improve bike lanes and multi-use paths for bicyclist and pedestrian safety

Measure U continues strict fiscal accountability protections:

- Every penny must stay here in Truckee
- Funds can be used for trails and bike lanes only
- By law, no funds can be taken away by the State
- An independent citizens' oversight committee and annual audits ensure funds are spent as promised
- Visitors and second homeowners pay their fair share
- Essential purchases like groceries and prescription medicine are exempt, ensuring the cost is not a burden to those on fixed or limited incomes.
