In California, the increasingly large wildfires have had a major impact on meeting the needs for evacuating, sheltering, providing shelter-in-place care, and reunification for companion animals, livestock, and equine. California CARTs are collaborating with state agencies to provide mutual-aid to help affected counties who require additional care resources for long-term responses.

Summit 2022 Objectives

- Focus on mutual-aid options for large-scale incidents
- CARTs to share top strategies for effective planning, mutual-aid considerations, and deployment
- Receive updates on the new California Veterinary Emergency Team (CVET) program at UC Davis.
- Updates on *Shelterly*, a cloud-based program developed by the North Valley Animal Disaster Group for disaster tracking and shelter management.

There will be speakers from the CA Dept. of Food & Agriculture, CA Office of Emergency Services, the University of CA, Davis and the CA Animal Welfare Association.
