Opening Procedures

There's a lot of steps—but don't panic

- Plenty of people to help
- Call if you don't know
- You'll have Job Cards

Vote Center Manager

Ongoing Responsibilities

Every Hour

- Check and tidy voting booths
- Make sure you have enough ballot stock and supplies by checking ballot count on tablet screen
- Make sure Master and Public Label Rosters are updated

As Needed

- Conduct breaks / lunch for clerks
- Check security seals
- Provide provisionals, CVRs, line management assistance
- Check in and monitor election observers, media

Opening Procedures

- Arrive 60 minutes before
- Complete your timecard!
- Take the Oath of Office
- Take breaks
- Bring meals and snacks
- Wear comfortable, business casual clothes
- Follow all procedures
- Ask questions if you're unsure of what to do

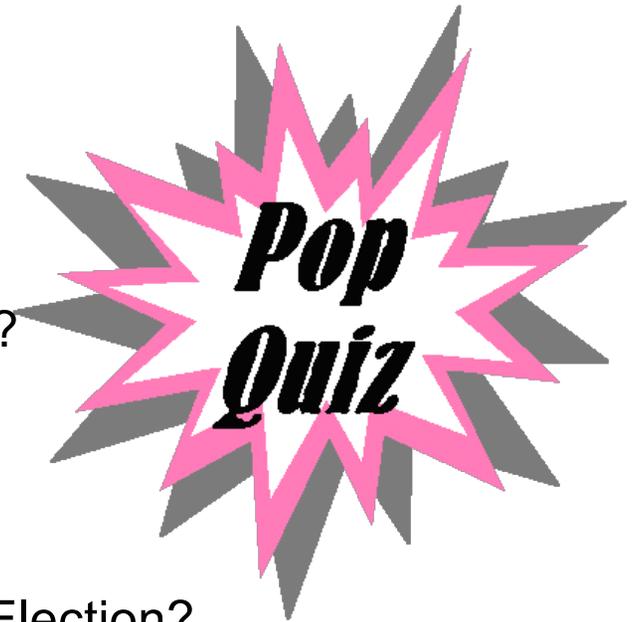

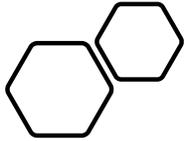

Opening Procedures

- Red Seals—never remove without express authority
- Blue and White Seals—okay to remove

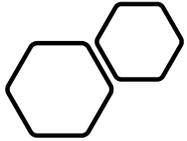


Opening Procedures

Verify Security Seals

- All Vote Center Workers shall ensure that seals are verified and accounted for.
- Seal verification helps ensure an unbroken chain-of-custody of the voting equipment, laptops, ballot stock, and all other sensitive equipment and materials distributed to Vote Centers.
- Never throw an official seal in the trash.
- If seal numbers do not match—STOP. Call the Elections Office or immediately.





Opening Procedures

There will be seals on

- Touch Writers
- Verity Print
- Scanner
- Oki Printers
- Silver Cabinet
- Ballot Box



Opening Procedures

First, confirm that the Blue Sticker Seal is intact on the Silver Cabinet

Break the Blue Sticker Seal and fix it to the log inside the Silver Cabinet

Take out all laptops and Oki printer trays



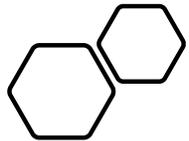
Opening Procedures

Vote Center Managers:

- You must have a co-worker help you
- Take out your Daily Audit Binder and complete the “Before Open” fields on the day’s Vote Center Accounting Worksheet (for Verity Print, Touch Writers, and Scanner)
- Store the White Wire Seals that you cut off the voting equipment and voting machine reports in a Banker’s Bag (zipped pouch)
- Record the Red Sticker Seal that you apply on the Ballot Box Front Door on your Vote Center Accounting Worksheet

Opening Procedures

- Check In Clerks: take laptops, Oki Printer trays, and ballot paper to your check in table and begin set up
 - Vote Center Managers and Floor Assistants: take the Oki Printer trays, and ballot paper to the Touch Writers and start up the machines
 - Laptops and voting equipment are your first priority—they are the most important part of the voting process at vote centers
- Everyone: Job Cards are there to help you!

Opening Procedures

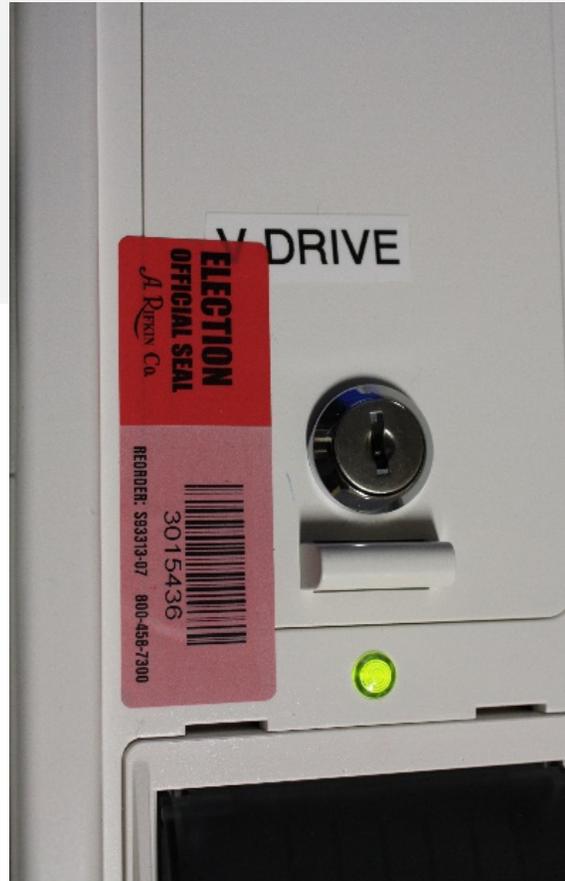
There are 3 kinds of seals on the voting equipment

- White Wire Seals on the handles
- Red Sticker Seals over the V-Drive compartments
- Red Wire Seals protecting the “brain” on the back of the tablet

You must record all White Wire Seal numbers!

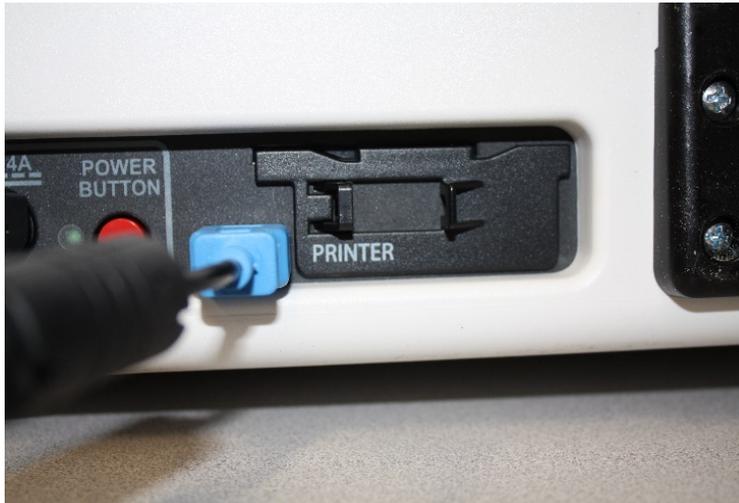
Red Seals must be intact!

2 people must verify!

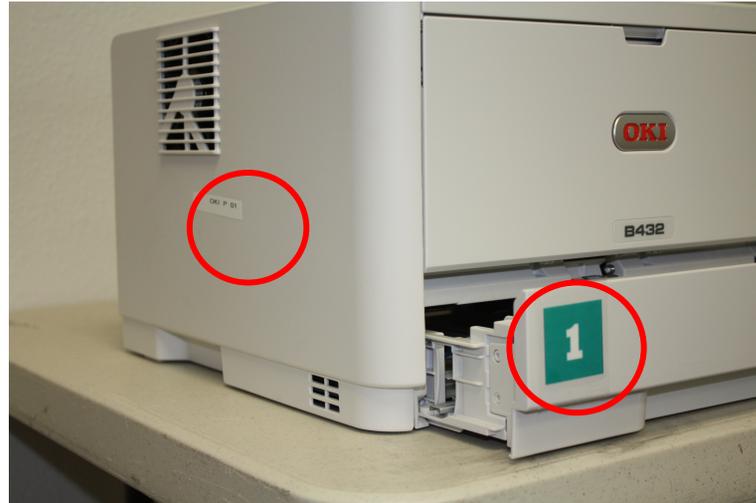


Opening Procedures

Make sure everything is plugged in—including printers!



Place the Oki Printer tray in the corresponding device and make sure it has official ballot paper in it



Opening Procedures

Turn on the Oki Printer. Make sure it reads "Ready to Print"



Break the White Wire Seal on the handle of the machine.



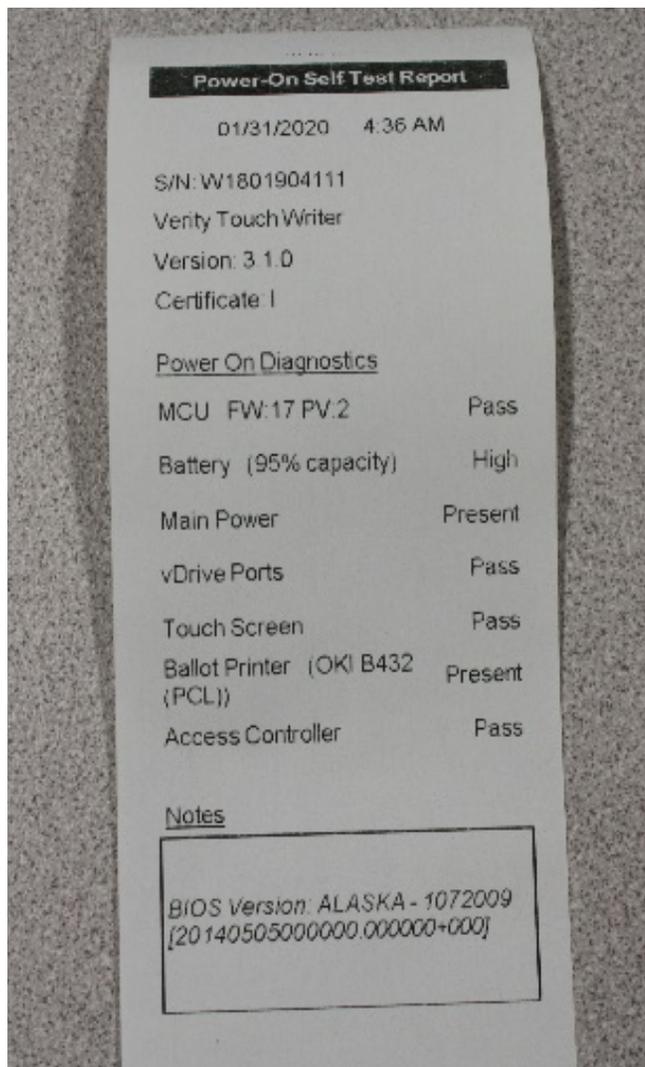
Opening Procedures

Open up the case. Use Vote Center Keys to release and dock the tablet.



Power the machine on

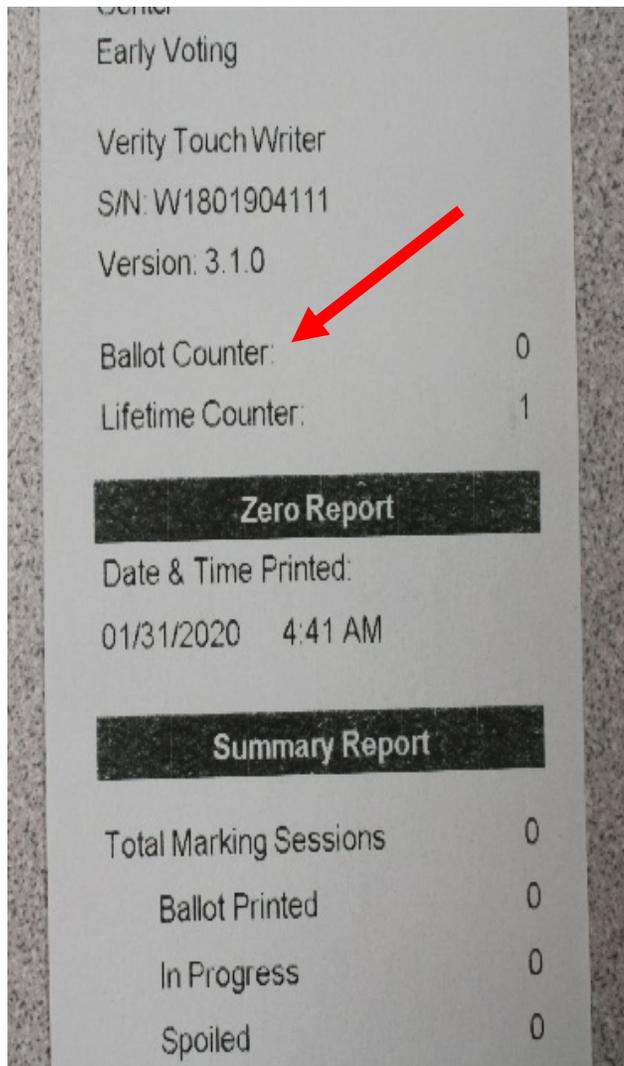




Opening Procedures

3 reports you should know about

1. Power-On Self Test Report
2. Zero/Summary Report
3. Open Polls Report



Opening Procedures

Check your ballot counter

- Must read zero on the first day of voting and on Election Day
- Can be another number any other day the vote center is open for early voting
- Repeat for all machines

Daily Accounting

You must keep track of:

- Used blank ballot stock
- Number of ballots cast during the day
- CVR and Provisional ballots issued
- Preprinted ballot stock used throughout the day
- Spoiled and surrendered ballots

All accounting activities are tracked with the Vote Center Accounting Worksheets found in the Daily Audit Binder. There are some lines to complete in the morning, which will help when you close out for the day.

Daily Accounting

You have a checklist to help you keep track of what you need to report for the day

Be sure that you record Red Sticker Seal numbers as needed

If there's any discrepancies with your daily accounting, please use the "Election Staff Notes" lines to explain what happened

Elections Staff Accounting Checklist:

- Red Sticker Seal Applied to Ballot Box Front Door: G0123456789
- Write in all voting equipment numbers and associated Oki Printers
- Write in all broken and new White Wire Seal numbers
- Place all broken White Wire Seals in the Banker's Bag
- Place all reports printed by the voting equipment in the Banker's Bag
- Confirm that the Vote Center Accounting Worksheet is complete
- Confirm that all items are in the Blue Transport Bag (Line 15)
- Seal the Blue Transport Bag with a White Wire Seal
- Election Staff Notes _____

Daily Accounting

Line A: Ballot-On-Demand (Verity Print)

- Write in the number assigned to that machine and the associated Oki printer.
- Write down the number of the white wire seal that you removed from the handle
- Find the Ballot Counter line on the tablet and record the number – on the first day of voting, this should read zero
- Repeat for all Verity Print

Line G: Ballot Marking Devices (Touch Writers)

- Write in the number assigned to that machine and the associated Oki printer
- Write down the number of the white wire seal that you removed from the handle
- Find the Ballot Counter line on the tablet and record the number – on the first day of voting, this should read zero
- Repeat for all Touch Writers

Line H: Verity Scan (the Scanner)

- Write in the number assigned to the Scanner
- Write down the number of the white wire seal that you removed from the handle
- Find the Ballot Counter line on the tablet and record the number– on the first day of voting, this should read zero

Opening procedures



- Once Verity loads you can open the polls on the Touch Writers and Scanner
- Use your Badge to get the Open Polls Code
- Verity Print will ask for a Poll Worker Code, which will also be on your badge
- The open polls report will print. It verifies that the polls are open on that machine.

All reports and White Wire Seals go into the Banker's Bag in the Daily Audit Binder

Opening Procedures

Plug the headphones into the Touch Writers

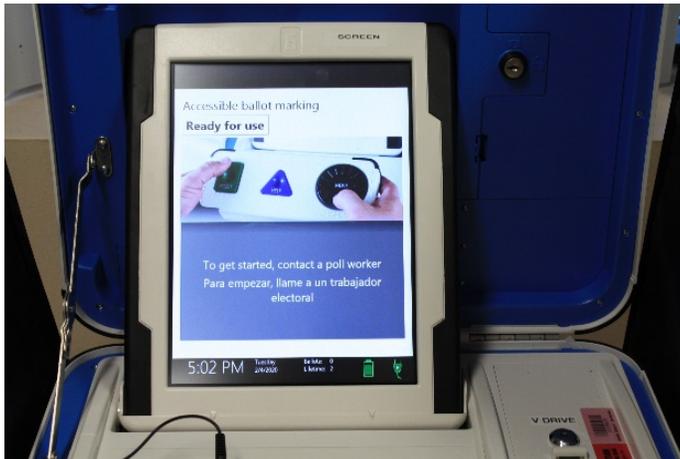


Put a fresh pair of ear covers on the headphones

Wipe down the equipment with the disinfecting wipes provided



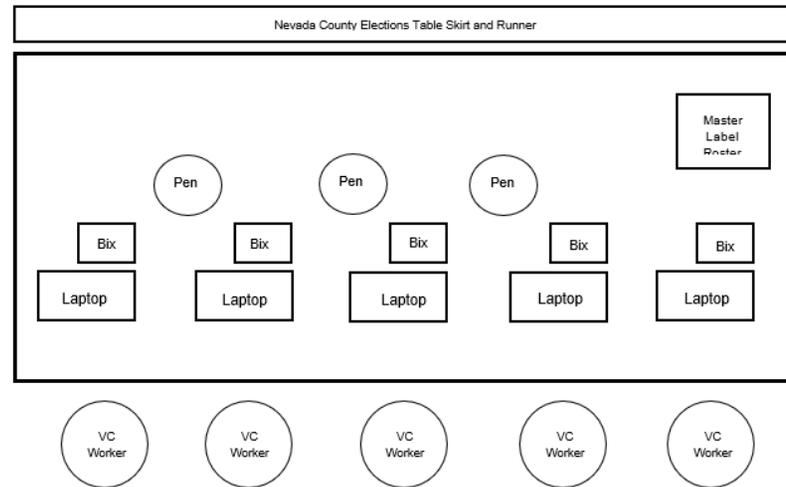


Hang Signs

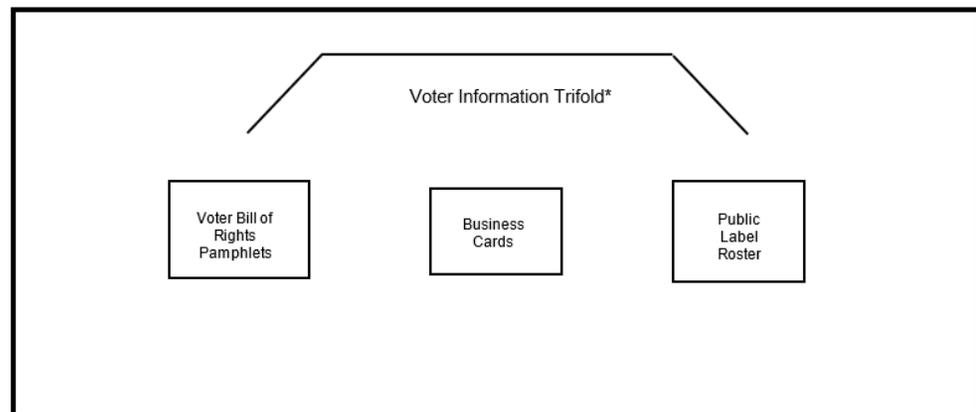

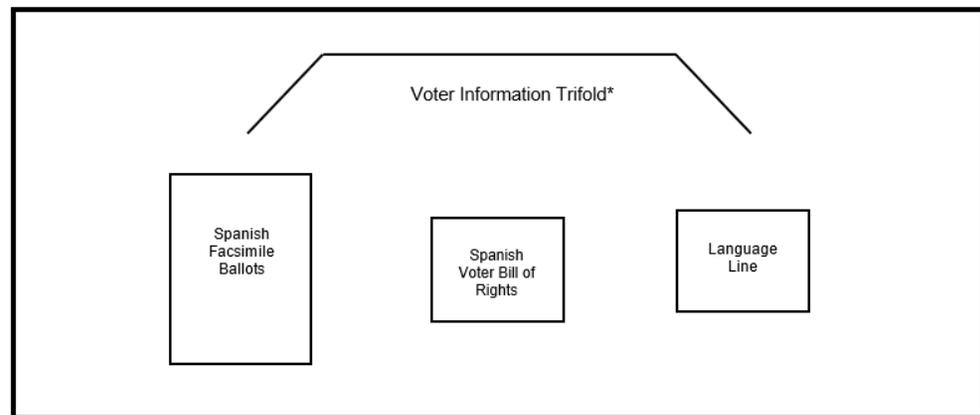

Spanish Voter Information Table

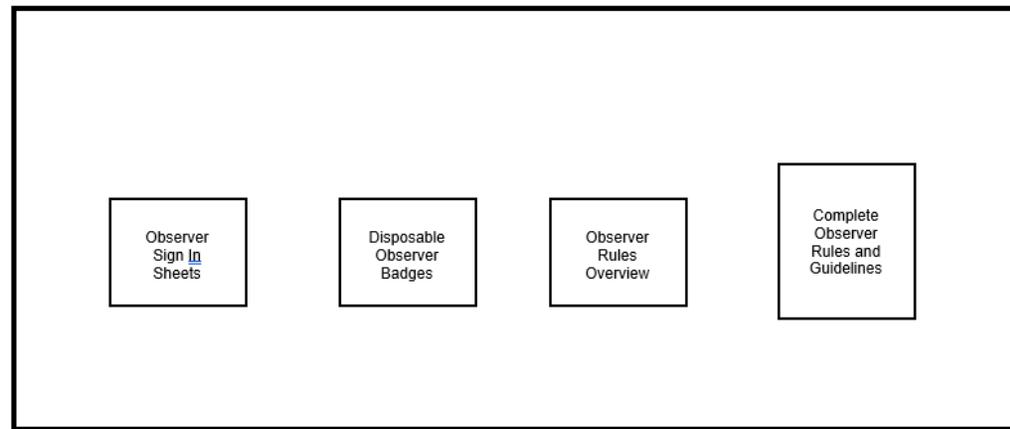

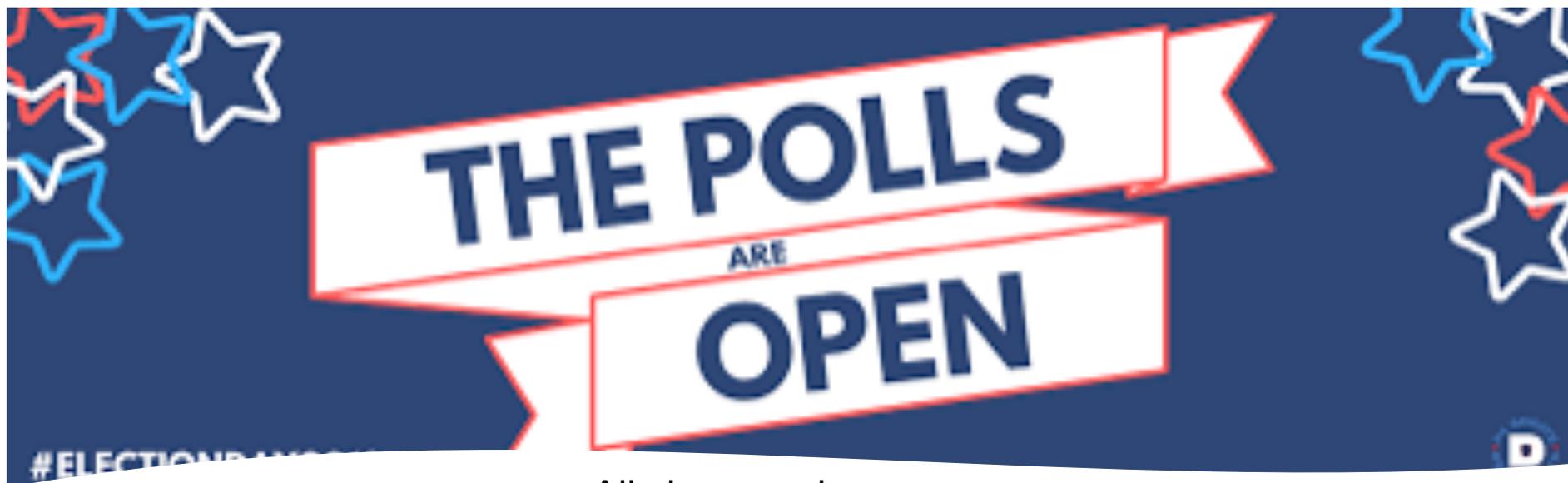

Opening Procedures

- All signs are hung
- Check in table is set and laptops powered on
- Supply table is stocked
- Voting equipment is on and secure
- Vote center looks tidy

First Voter Procedure

- Ask the First Voter to confirm aloud that ballot counters on all machines read zero and that the V-Drive compartments are sealed
- Ask the First Voter to confirm aloud that there are no ballots in the ballot box and the seal on the back door of the ballot box is intact
- Close and seal the ballot box door with a Red Sticker Seal
- Record the Red Sticker Seal Number in the Vote Center Accounting Worksheet
