Course Description:

This is a 120-hour certified course required by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (P.O.S.T.) for individuals interested in obtaining certification needed for employment as a law enforcement dispatcher. This course is open to incumbent law enforcement dispatchers as well as those individuals interested in entering the career field. Individuals completing this course will receive a P.O.S.T. Public Safety Dispatcher Certificate. According to POST, attendees are only able to miss 5% or 6 hours of the total amount of hours for the course.

Topics of instruction will include professional orientation and ethics, introduction to law and the criminal justice system, missing persons, domestic violence, community policing, cultural diversity, child and elder abuse, law enforcement telecommunications, radio technology and procedures, and handling of critical incidents. The course will include instructional activities in each learning domain, and will culminate in an eight-hour final day of practical application through various scenarios and exercises.

Students are REQUIRED to bring laptops with WiFi capabilities to class on the first day as course materials will be available online in Canvas.

Fees & Materials:

Total cost per student is \$374.00. Total cost for out of state students is \$2,194.00. This fee is approximate and subject to change at any time. P.O.S.T. Plan IV. Agency personnel will be reimbursed for daily subsistence. Students will receive 6.5 semester units of college credit for successful attendance.

Registration Information:

This class is AJLE-164-M1096 (Control #1096), Summer 2022. Registration is scheduled to begin Tuesday, May 17, 2022.

Payment Policy:
