

## RESOLUTION 2022-08

### RESOLUTION CALLING AN ELECTION REQUESTING VOTER APPROVAL FOR AN INCREASE IN THE SPENDING LIMIT UNDER PROPOSITION 4 AT AN ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 8, 2022

WHEREAS, the voters of the Penn Valley Fire Protection District previously approved special tax measures to support fire protection, prevention and suppression, emergency medical care and ambulance service within the District; and

WHEREAS, whenever two or more elections are called to be held on the same day, in the same territory, or in part of the same territory, such elections should be consolidated; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Penn Valley Fire Protection District has determined that in order to be able to use the special taxes as previously approved by the voters for providing fire protection, fire prevention, and ambulance and rescue/emergency services in the District, the District's "spending limit" established under Proposition 4 (Article XIII B of the California Constitution) must be increased, otherwise the District will be critically reduced in the level of services it could provide in future years, and

WHEREAS, Article XIII B of the California Constitution provides that the spending limit imposed may be changed by the electors.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Penn Valley Fire Protection District of the County of Nevada, State of California, does hereby RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Directors hereby calls a special election to be held on November 8, 2022 for the purpose of requesting that the voters of the Penn Valley Fire Protection District authorize a change in the spending ("appropriation") limit established for the Penn Valley Fire Protection District, under Article XIII B of the California Constitution (and Government Code Sections 7900 et seq.) for a period of the next four (4) fiscal years, in order to allow the District to retain and spend all taxes received by it during that period. If approved by the voters, the increase in the spending limit will be effective beginning with the 2022/2023 fiscal year and for the following three (3) fiscal years and shall not require any further action by this Board.

2. Pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10402 and 10403 request is hereby made to the governing board of the County of Nevada to consolidate the regularly scheduled district election with any other elections to be held on November 8, 2022.
3. The Clerk of the County of Nevada shall be authorized to render all services necessary for the conduct of the election.
4. The Board of Supervisors is authorized to canvass the results of the election.
5. That the precincts, polling places, and precinct election board members shall be the same as those provided for in the November 8, 2022, general election.
6. The Penn Valley Fire Protection District shall reimburse the County of Nevada for the district's prorated share of the costs of the election.
7. That the language of the measure shall be as follows: Shall the Penn Valley Fire Protection District appropriation limit under Article XIII B of the California Constitution be increased to allow expenditure of the dollars already collected for the purpose of providing fire protection and emergency medical services in the Penn Valley Fire Protection District for fiscal years 2023 through 2026 This measure would NOT increase taxes or impose a new tax. It would authorize expenditure of already approved taxes for FY 2023 through 2026.






