DEPUTY SHERIFF'S BARGAINING UNIT**

HOME RETENTION OF VEHICLES

A. BACKGROUND

The County and the Deputy Sheriff's Association (DSA), acknowledge there is currently a Nevada County Sheriff's Office policy, Lexipol 703 "Vehicle Use", which lays out expectations of employees as it relates to County vehicle usage. Nothing in this side letter of agreement is meant to supersede that policy or any portion thereof. If there is a potential perceived conflict between the two documents, the Sheriff's Office policy shall be the controlling authority.

B. CONDITIONS

The County and DSA agree that no employee who is assigned a County vehicle for home-retention will seek any additional compensation for travel time to and from their assigned duty station before or after their assigned shift unless the employee has been called to report to the scene of an emergency outside their normal working hours and is traveling to that emergency.
