COURSE DATE: Tuesday, February 7, 2023, 8:00am – 5:00pm

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This eight-hour introductory course was created by the State Threat Assessment System to familiarize students with the fundamental concepts of vulnerability assessments. This course explains one method for completing a vulnerability assessment that is used by fusion centers in California. This course examines the following topics: pre-assessment meetings, field assessments (vulnerabilities and mitigation options), reports, brief back meetings, and resources.

TARGET AUDIENCE: This course is designed to assist **School Resource Officers** or other personnel that conduct vulnerability assessments such as:

- **School Administrators**
- **School Security/Maintenance**

COURSE OBJECTIVES: Upon completion of the course the student should be able to:

- Articulate the importance of vulnerability assessments and situational awareness
- Understand the purpose of each step in the vulnerability process
- Identify common vulnerabilities encountered at schools and be able to provide mitigation options
- Conduct their own vulnerability assessments of schools in their districts
