Forcible Entry for Patrol response to an Active Shooter Event

This event is designed to provide a safe working environment on the topic of breaching for patrol. The **FREE** seminar is based off the premise of worst-case scenarios such as an active shooter event. This free seminar will concentrate on outward and inward opening doors primarily. In addition to this there will be a review of windows and padlocks. Upon completion of the seminar, you will be familiar with the basic understandings of breaching and construction of the door and jamb. The attendee will be able to identify different style doors including panic bar doors and other fire rated material that change the method of breaching at times. The attendee is encouraged to bring forcible entry equipment they use or own for a service call where emergency breaching would be required. If the Attendee does not have equipment JTC will provide equipment for all students to use. Attendees do not have to participate in the physical breaching exercises.
