Fentanyl Overdose Investigations

Monday, November 6th, 2023, (0800-1700)
CNOA Region 1 and NCHIDTA are jointly hosting this class.

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course will discuss the rise of the opioid epidemic in the U.S., particularly the rise of Fentanyl and the distribution of counterfeit M-30 pills containing Fentanyl. The class will review various case studies to learn how to safely respond and investigate the scene of an overdose whether a fatality occurred. This class will prepare you to act in an undercover roll by using social media to identify and arrest the suspected distributors of Fentanyl pills and powder. Finally, the class will review various federal charges related to overdoses and overdose deaths and prepare investigators for successful prosecution related to Fentanyl overdoses and overdose deaths. This class is beneficial for patrol officers, detectives, and supervisors.

INSTRUCTORS: Dean Cardinale is currently a Detective with the Fresno Police Department and has been employed by FPD for the past 26 years. Dean has spent the last 10 years in the FPD Major Narcotics Unit where he has worked over 300 drug investigations. For the past seven years, Dean has been assigned as a TFO for the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) in Fresno, CA. Recently, Dean has created the Fentanyl Overdose Resolution Team (FORT) which consists of Special Agents and TFO's from DEA and Homeland Security Investigations (HIS). The FORT focuses on solving fentanyl overdoses with or without a fatality and conducting investigations involving the distribution of fentanyl in the Fresno County area. Dean and the FORT have completed 44 fentanyl related fentanyl overdoses and distribution cases for federal prosecution. Dean along with the FORT was featured in the Emmy nominated ABC documentary "Killer High: The Silent Crisis".
