

Fin Type Flashing Detail

- ① Lap pan flashing over flap of housewrap. Then set window into sealant on top and two sides.

- ② Install side splines, then head flashing. Later weave housewrap under flap and tape along side jambs.

Egress Window Replacement

If the existing rough opening is not altered or enlarged, then the new window is not required to comply with current egress requirements provided the new assembly does not reduce the openable dimensions to less than that of the existing assembly or make the window more dangerous to the occupants. *It is highly recommended that existing non-compliant bedroom egress windows be upgraded to meet current code requirements.*
