Recovery Incentives Program

NEW EFFECTIVE TREATMENT FOR STIMULANT USE DISORDER!

Benefits Include:

- Reduced stimulant use
- Reduced stimulant cravings
- Increased number of days in treatment

How does the recovery incentives program work?

The Recovery Incentives Program provides Medi-Cal beneficiaries with small gift cards totaling up to \$599 for not using meth, cocaine, or other stimulants, as measured by negative drug tests. Participants are rewarded for behavior change, and receive support on their path to recovery.

If you are enrolled in Medi-Cal and have a diagnosis of moderate or severe stimulant use disorder, you can participate in this program.

How long is the program?

The outpatient treatment lasts 24 weeks.

You must attend an in-office visit 2 times a week for 12 weeks. You then must attend an in-office visit 1 time a week for 12 more weeks.

Can you get medication assisted treatment (MAT) while in the program?

If you have Medi-Cal and qualify for the program, you can keep getting other Substance Use Disorder treatments, including MAT.

This program is not meant to replace MAT for opioid use or alcohol use disorders.

You are not required to enroll in any other treatment program to participate in the recovery incentive program.
