Title: Qualification Shoot

Purpose: To show proficiency with office issued handguns (Sig P226/P229) or office approved (Glock 22/23)

Equipment:

1. Sig P226/P229 department issued handgun or Glock 22/23
2. 3 magazines
3. Holster
4. Magazine pouch
5. 30 rounds
6. EXC-TT1 Target

Procedure:

1. Students will approach the firing line with a complete safe weapon and 3 magazines loaded with 10 rounds each.
2. On command, students will insert one 10 round magazine into a holstered duty weapon.
3. On command, students will draw weapon and chamber 1 round, de-cock, and re-holster their weapon.
4. On the command threat: students will engage their target. When empty, Students will drop their magazine, insert a new magazine, and place their weapon at the low-ready.
5. Upon command, students will re-holster a live weapon.
6. Upon completion of the final stage of fire, students will simulate a magazine re-load and come to the low ready.
7. Upon command, students will ensure a complete safe weapon, verify with another student they have a complete safe weapon, de-cock and re-holster their weapon.

Course of fire:

1. 7 yards. 10 rounds. Strong hand. Standing. 30 seconds.
2. 15 yards. 10 rounds. Strong hand. Standing. 60 seconds.
3. 25 yards. 10 rounds. Strong hand. Standing. 90 seconds.

Practice Course: Practice course shall be conducted as above, using the EXC-TT1 target. Practice course shall not be scored.

Qualifying Course: Rounds striking the black silhouette of the target shall be counted as a hit. Rounds striking fully outside the black silhouette shall be scored a miss. Shooters must demonstrate safe weapons handling, with a qualifying score of 30 hits to the black silhouette.
