Animal Control Officer pistol qualification:

Purpose: To demonstrate proficiency with the department issued revolver

Equipment:

1. Department issued revolver.
2. Duty belt with holster
3. 18 rounds
4. EXC-TT1 Target

Procedure:

1. Students will approach the firing line with a completely safe weapon, holstered.
2. On command, students will unholster their weapon, open the cylinder, load six rounds into the cylinder, close the cylinder and re-holster the weapon.
3. On the command of fire, students will draw their weapon and engage the target with all six rounds. The student may fire in single action or double action. When the cylinder is empty, the students will re-load the cylinder with six more rounds and re-holster.
4. Upon completion of the final stage of fire, students will open the cylinder on their revolver and ensure a safe weapon. Once weapon has been deemed safe, students will close the cylinder, re-holster and leave the firing line.

Course of Fire:

1. 3 yards. 6 rounds. Standing. 45 seconds
2. 5 yards. 6 rounds. Standing. 60 seconds
3. 10 yards. 6 rounds. Standing. 90 seconds

Practice Course: Practice course shall be conducted as above, using the EXC-TT1 target. Practice course shall not be scored.

Qualifying Course: Rounds striking the black silhouette of the target shall be counted as a hit. Rounds striking fully outside the black silhouette shall be scored a miss. Shooters must demonstrate safe weapons handling, with a qualifying score of 18 hits to the black silhouette.
