



Basic Crisis Negotiation Course

Description: This course will provide theory and practice to resolve crisis, hostage, barricade and suicide situations through active listening, assessment, and other negotiating techniques. The 40 hour course is intended for individuals currently assigned to hostage negotiation teams. Attendees must be sworn peace officers or tactical dispatchers sponsored by their department. Extensive role plays and team exercises are employed in this training.
