Update Regarding Truckee Aircraft Crash

Truckee, CA – The Nevada County Sheriff's Office confirms two individuals lost their lives following this past weekend's plane crash on March 30, 2024 near Glenshire Drive in Truckee. While there have been reports circulating naming the potential victims of the crash, the Sheriff's Office is unable to substantiate such claims at this time. Due to the violent impact of the plane crash and subsequent fire of the plane, the identification of the occupants remains pending at this time until forensic analysis can be completed, which will take several days, if not longer. The National Transportation Safety Board (NTSB) is the lead agency investigating the crash. The Sheriff's Office is the coroner responsible for identifying the victims and conducting the death investigation. Names will be released as soon as they are conclusively confirmed.
