Virtual Travel Consultation \$35.00

Offices are full-service travel medicine clinics, CDC-certified Yellow Fever vaccination centers. Travel Specialists will meet with you, your travel partners via a virtual meeting. They will review your itinerary, discuss vaccine recommendations/requirements, and educate you on how to avoid getting sick.

The virtual meeting lasts around 45 minutes and is required before scheduling an office visit for your vaccinations. Should you decide to receive any prescriptions with us, these will be called into the pharmacy after the virtual consult.

The only vaccine needed to travel is Yellow Fever. All other vaccines are recommendations to make certain you don't become ill while traveling abroad.

\$35 Virtual Travel Consultation

At a virtual consultation, we will discuss your specific traveling situation including the following topics:

- How do you contract (and consequently avoid) each disease?
- What is the relative risk (1:2 vs 1:2000000) of contracting that disease during your trip?
- How much will it cost to eliminate that risk with a vaccine?
- Yellow Fever and Yellow Card Certificate Japanese Encephalitis (pre-order)
- Typhoid Fever (oral and injectable) Malaria – medication before, during, after
- Pneumonia Hepatitis A and B
- Tdap Polio
- Meningitis Influenza (Flu)
- MMR Routine adult/child boosters available.
- Rabies (pre-order)

Pre-payment will be taken for all services performed, cleared for at the completion of the consult by the travel nurse. Please note, the cost of medication is additional and will be paid directly to the pharmacy in addition to the \$35 Prescription Fee paid to WellnessMart.

Includes consult, vaccine administration, documentation, RX. Client(s) pay choose to receive vaccines same day or return in the future. Recommended to obtain vaccines 4 – 6 weeks prior to travel.
