What containers does the CRV program cover?

- Carbonated mineral and soda water and other similar carbonated soft drinks
- Noncarbonated soft drinks
- Wine coolers and distilled spirit coolers
- Wine and distilled spirits
- Beer and malt beverages
- Noncarbonated water including noncarbonated mineral water
- Sport drinks
- Coffee and tea drinks
- Vegetable juice in beverage containers
- Carbonated and noncarbonated fruit drinks with any percentage of fruit juice
- 100% fruit juice containers: glass, plastic, aluminum, or bimetal



Where can I take CRV containers locally to receive the refund?

- **Customers may request to be paid per container** for up to 50 California Refund Value (CRV) beverage containers of each material type per transaction. Check the container for the CRV value.

Daily load limits of empty CRV beverage containers are:
100 pounds each for aluminum and plastic and
1,000 pounds for glass



Before you go

- Non-CRV materials must be removed from the load, or the recycling center may reject the load or pay only the scrap value for the material. Non eligible containers include: milk, medical, food, infant formula, juice boxes, juice pouches, juice cartons and non-beverage containers.
- Make sure containers are whole and free of contaminants such as dirt, liquid, or other substances.
- Caps must be removed from containers.
- Sort different materials prior to arriving.
