## BE AWARE OF THE FORECAST ✓



### Winter Storm Watch - BE PREPARED.

Hazardous winter weather may occur within 48 hours.

### Winter Storm Warning - TAKE ACTION.

Hazardous weather is occurring or imminent.

## PLAN FOR MEDICAL DEVICES ✓



- Wear water resistant clothing and footwear when outside.
- Have a plan if your home becomes too cold. Visit a warming center or stay with a friend or family.

## EAT & HYDRATE ✓

- Stock up on easy to prepare, shelf-stable foods.
- Keep perishables in a cooler chilled with ice or snow.
- Have enough water for drinking and cleaning.
- Have a camp stove and fuel on hand.
- If on a well, fill bathtubs with water.

- Top off your propane tank. If you have a whole house generator, conserve fuel. Expect propane deliveries to be delayed.
- Stock up on fuel for tools like generators, snow blowers, and chainsaws.
- Charge battery banks to keep devices operable.
- Charge electric vehicles and fill up fuel tanks.
- Ensure you have a snow shovel to keep walkways & driveways clear.
