

What C&D materials can be recycled?

- Asphalt (roads and roofing shingles)
- Brick
- Carpet
- Doors
- Concrete (4' or smaller) For drop-off location, see 14 on map
- Glass
- Linoleum
- Metal
- Plastics
- Plumbing fixtures (sinks, toilets, etc.)
- PVC piping
- Sheetrock
- Sheet insulation
- Windows
- Wood (including painted)
- Tile

What C&D is not accepted?

- Treated wood waste, including pressure treated wood, telephone poles and railroad ties. These materials are considered hazardous waste and are accepted in the treated wood receiving area at the transfer station. For drop-off location see 13 on the map.
- No dirt, soil, rocks or fines (very small, dust-like particles of crushed rock, dirt, or soil)
- No asbestos containing products or burned debris.
