Subject: Fish and Wildlife Commission Grants for Fiscal Year 2025 - 2026

To Whom It May Concern,

The Nevada County Fish and Wildlife Commission is scheduled to meet **Tuesday, December 2nd, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.** During this meeting the Commission will hear grant proposals from community partners on projects that benefits the fish or wildlife resources of the County and that meet the requirements of Fish and Game Code Section 13103. There is up to \$7,500 from the Fish and Wildlife Propagation Fund will be available. Projects that protect, conserve, propagate, and/or preserve fish or wildlife resources in the County are encouraged to apply.

The Nevada County Fish and Wildlife Propagation Fund is entirely supported by fine revenues resulting from violations of Fish and Game laws and regulations in the County. The recommendations of the Nevada County Fish and Wildlife Commission will be forwarded to the Nevada County Board of Supervisors, which has final decision-making authority for expenditures from the Fund.

As a reminder, the Commission has recently implemented new procedures for all applicants. It includes the requirement to complete the enclosed application and return to the Nevada County Department of Agriculture via email agdept@nevadacountyca.gov.

The deadline to submit your application, via email, is November 30th, 2025. A presentation to the Commission on your proposed project at their December 2nd, 2025 meeting is strongly recommended.
