

HOW TO RECYCLE METAL




Packing your load

Metal and other recyclables should be loaded so they are easily dropped off before weighing in at the scales with other materials.

What type of metal can be recycled?

All metals are accepted, however, no metal cylinders of any type, nor solar panels. (Solar panels can be taken to Recology, 12305 Shale Road, Auburn.)



Know before you drop off metal

- Engines/compressors of any type must have all liquids and batteries removed
- Electric devices that require batteries must have batteries removed
- Large pieces should be no longer than 4-feet long
- No full size vehicles/boats/trailers are accepted
- No hazardous waste or unused ammunition accepted
- Trailers/lawn mowers, etc. must have tires removed. If trailer has been registered with DMV, a Junk slip from DVM must accompany trailer before disposal
- All barrels must be completely empty, cleaned and ends cutoff

HOW TO RECYCLE APPLIANCES



Some appliances cost

All refrigerated units and appliances with hazardous properties will be charged a disposal fee. If a refrigerated unit no longer has freon, a fee is still charged for processing its hazardous materials. Appliances must be paid for at the transfer station's scale house before dropping off.



Free to drop off appliances

- Microwaves
- Trash compactor
- Furnace

\$ Appliances that require a disposal fee

- Dishwasher
- Water heater
- Water dispenser
- Washing machine
- Clothes dryer
- Hot water heater
- Dehumidifier
- Oven
- Stove
- Refrigerator/ammonia, freon and propane
- Freezer
- Air-conditioner
